The Affordable Care Act (ACA): Breast Pump Coverage is required

Most supply a purchase

Rental pumps may be covered for certain medical needs (see back of page for details)

Where and when will my insurance pay for one?

Most provide a pump from a local medical equipment store (DME)

Some insurances provide a pump from a supplier

Call your insurance's customer service number on your card before you deliver!

1. Where can I get my pump? DME (store in Rochester, ship to home) or National (ship to home only)?
2. Is there a specific breast pump that is covered up to me?
3. Can I get my pump before I deliver?

Which pump should I get?

Many double electric pumps can pump both sides at the same time and work well

BUT, some pumps can cause more harm than good
