 - o Matching colored words on a screen
 - o Answering a standard cognitive test
 - Answering a demographic survey

If answering differently to the matching test on the screen is related to variations in brain signals.

This will give us better understanding on how human working memory functions.

In the future, it will allow us to look for associations between risk factors for Alzheimer's disease, the performance on the matching test and the brain signals.
