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## **ABSTRACT**

Title: Internet Use among Caregivers of Urban Childreh Wetrsistent Asthma

Background: Asthma is the most common chronic disease of childhood, disproportionately affecting poor and minority children. The internet is now commonly used as a platform to share health information, however little is known about howaregivers of urban children with persistent asthma use the Internet.

Objective 1) Describe the use of the Internet among urban caregivers of children with asthma; 2) Explore associations between Internet use and ociodemographic, sasthma symptom easures, medications, and healthcare utilization.

Design/Methods We used data from the chool Based Telemedicine Enhanced Asthma Management (SBTEAM) program for elementary school echildren with persistent asthma in urban Rochester, NY. We conducted inhome, structured surveys with caregivers to assess children's demographic information, healthcare utilization (prior year), asthma severity and symptoms (prior 14 days). Caregivers reported current tuse at home based on Pewervey items.
