Conclusion: Our hypothesis was confirmed in that manediatric survivors of violent injurgontinue to experience negative hysical and mental functional outcomes Many participants reported worse function in the PROMIS domains of Global Physical Health, Global Mental Health and Physical Function compared with the general population Our results suggest that the lasting effects of viole interview reach far beyond mortality and economic burden. Indeed, the deditional burdens were still preserve ars after the impury. Nearly half of subjects still report symptoms of PTSD. Based on our initial study, survivors of pediatric violent injuries often have lasting ailments that require medical and psycholes gipport. Further resources are needed to better understand on the result of violent injury and care for these patients' complex needs to allow them to achieve their full potential as people in the community.
