

PGY2 Specialty Pharmacy Administration Residency Program
Completion of Minimum Program Requirements

1. NYS Licensure Per Resident Licensure Policy
2. Required goals and objectives
 - a. At minimum, 80% of all objectives met (ASHP-7.7 ())
 1. Patient satisfaction annually (Administered in November, presented in August)
 2. Patient satisfaction annually (Administered in November, presented in February)
 3. AHRQ Survey on Patient Safety Culture (SOPS) annually administered in January, presented in February
 - a. Subject to change frequency if there is an update to clinical documentation
 4. Employee Engagement annually: Stay Survey/Press Ganey (timing varies)
 - b. Clinical Oversight Committee (quarterly)
 - i. Call for agenda items, preparation of agenda and meeting minutes
15. Pharmacademic

- a. All assigned evaluations must be completed prior to the last day of residency
- b. Any evaluations requiring resident signature must be completed prior to the last day of residency

Requirement progress will be maintained on the resident development plan.

Presentation and/or other requirements may be revised at the discretion of the program director and coordinator during the residency year without prior notice
