Medical Family Therapy and Integrated Care Training Options

Fellows in the Integrated Care Family Psychology track have two options available for receiving training in medical family therapy and integrated care. The Psychology Training Program developed the 2-tier option in response to changes in federal tax laws that impact tuition reimbursement policies and procedures for all employers who offer tuition benefits. The option a fellow chooses has no bearing on recruitment as the fellow will not be asked to select an option until midway through the first semester of fellowship. Options are offered to provide fellows with levels of training that support their individual career goals while also giving them flexibility to control their out-of-pocket expenses.
