Rapid Response HIV Prevention

If you have had unprotected sex or shared needles within the last three days with someone who is or could be HIV+, the skilled pharmacists at Strong Memorial Hospital Outpatient Pharmacy can start you on treatment to prevent HIV infection. You do not need a prescription or an appointment to start treatment through our pharmacy.

We will:

Supply you with the initial seven days of treatment regardless of what insurance or financial barriers you have.

Guide you through the process and work with you to arrange a health care provider appointment within one to three days for follow-up to ensure you have access to the recommended 28 days of treatment and necessary follow-up testing and care.
