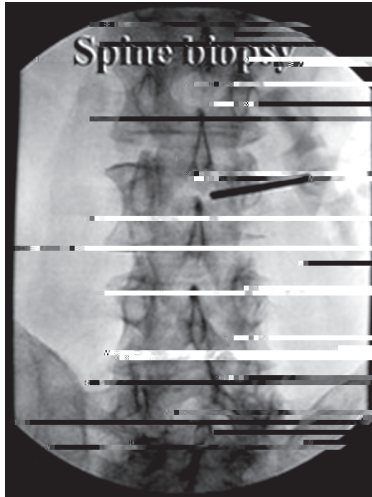


A **biopsy** is a procedure that obtains a specimen of tissue for microscopic examination by a medical specialist (pathologist).
