Health helped to make this a successful presentation.

Charles brought an engaging, animated presentation style that hit just the right cord. It was clear from student participation that they were listening and learning. He brought an "expert" along to further illuminate key points and

drive home the consequences of drinking.

More than half of the students handed in the evaluation sheet for the presentation. One student commented, "A lot of great points were made about drinking responsibly. Makes me think logically about drinking and using drugs before I choose to do it." Another pointed out, "It is not cool to drink at every party."

Sörensen Achieves Fellow Status

The council of the American
Psychological Association has voted Silvia
Sörensen, PhD to have Fellow Status.
Fellow status is an honor bestowed upon
APA members who have shown evidence of unusual and
outstanding contributions or performance in the field of
psychology. Fellow status requires that a person's work has had
a national impact on the field of psychology beyond a local,
state or regional level. A high level of competence or steady and
continuing contributions are not sufficient to warrant fellow
status. National impact must be demonstrated. The Fellows
